

e-Tourist Visa

Travelling to India requires a visa which can be obtained either from an Indian diplomatic mission or online (via **e-Tourist Visa**).

e- Tourist Visa (e-TV) is available to passport holders from the selected countries, e.g.

- Canada, Estonia, France, Germany, Latvia, Liechtenstein Lithuania
- Luxembourg, Montenegro, Norway, Republic of Macedonia
- Russia, Ukraine, USA, Vatican City - Holy See

Requirements for online visa application:

- **Valid passport for at least 6 months from the date of arrival** in India.
- **Front facing picture** against a white or light background without shadows and borders
- A **credit or debit card** to pay the visa fee of **\$ 60**
- Application **must be made at least 4 days** and maximum 30 days **before arrival** in India.

How to apply for an e-Tourist Visa?

1. Apply online via <https://indianvisaonline.gov.in/visa/info1.jsp>
Upload a **recent front facing photo** and the **photo page from your passport**.
2. Pay the **non-refundable** visa fee of **\$60** plus bank fees either via debit or credit card. The fee **must be paid at least 4 days before the expected date of travel**, so your application will be processed.
3. Receive eTV in your email account.
4. **Print the eTV** and **carry the document with you** when you travel to and be in India. When you arrive in India you will need to present your electronic travel authorization and have your biometrics recorded by immigration.

Once your electronic visa has been issued it will be **valid for 30 days from the date of arrival** and **cannot be extended**.

Your e-TV allows you to enter India via the following airports - Bengaluru, Chennai, Cochin, Delhi, Goa, Hyderabad, Kolkata, Mumbai & Trivandrum.

The e-Tourist Visa can only be obtained **twice within one year**.
